We hope to have about 90 teachers from 14 subjects attending Monday August 1 through 1 pm Friday August 4. The mid-morning, lunch, and mid-afternoon breaks are in the LPSC lobby. We will provide a table and two chairs. We should be able to locate your table next to an electrical outlet. You should bring an electrical extension cord.

All vehicles using a parking lot on the campus of Oregon State University must have a virtual parking pass. Visitors obtain a parking pass by going on-line and completing the required information about the vehicle. If you park on campus without a permit, you will receive a parking ticket. The Oregon APSI cannot negotiate with OSU Parking. When you register for a parking permit, be prepared to provide your vehicle(s)':

- ï License plate number
- ï Make
- ï Color
- ï Body Type (2 door, 4 door, SUV, etc.)
